**An appeal to His Holiness Pope Francis, Bishop of Rome
to convene a peace conference**

November 16, 2015

Your Holiness,

As the end of a difficult year 2015 comes to an end, I respectfully turn to you with a most urgent request that you, as the purest authority among personalities of the contemporary world, convene a global peace conference. We have every confidence in you as a person and holy authority. That you have become the first laureate of the "International Peace Prize from Slovakia 2015" through vote of our International Peace Committee is also an expression of our strong belief in you.

Since May 2014, our association members and personalities of domestic and international importance, which are steadily contributing to the improvement of economic and social conditions of life for broader strata of global population, are constantly interested in the causes and threats to peaceful life, dehumanization and self-destruction of our civilization.

Our association and its International Peace Committee has on several occasions approached the leaders of Central and Eastern Europe, United States of America and Russian Federation with suggestions for achieving a new quality of current living conditions. However, we are still waiting for their reply.

Currently, there is no less poverty, armed conflicts, wars and human misery than it was as we entered the new millennium. The widening social disparities, caused mainly by economic and especially financial colonization of most countries and their population are a bottomless abyss. Unfortunately, a whole number of representatives of the major superpowers, other powers and economically strong countries are convinced of their own exceptionalism, but less of their obligation to lead this world towards humanity. Such an order and organization in the world inevitably creates tensions not only within the states, but also in relations between individual countries or even between groups of states.

Highly revered Holy Father, I was prompted to send this urgent appeal to you after consultations with several personalities of our 23-years old association as well as with domestic and foreign members of our International Peace Committee. According to their views the current international situation is not only unbearable, it is critical. The process of problem solving is too slow and its effectiveness is in all aspects insufficient. Even after the terrorist attacks in Paris on November 13, 2015, there were not, except strongly worded state-

ments, any signs indicating that peaceful and dignified life is on the top of all priorities. Once again there is only a relentless battle for the leadership position among the superpowers, powers and a whole range of other countries, and justification of their own attitudes.

Behavior and actions of the representatives of the superpowers, USA and Russia, the UN and the European Union, states declaring themselves leaders, as well as the conduct of the representatives of the Slovak Republic at the end of 2015 in terms of their responsibility for peace are in our view insufficient at the present stage of our civilization and relations between states and their nations. It is clearly confirmed by the fact that concerns, expressed also by us in the spring of this year, about the wave of migration to Europe, greatly boosted by statements of the German Chancellor A. Merkel and by unprecedented passivity of the European Commission, were well founded.

Immutability of the order and functioning of the world is not predetermined. If the humankind is to survive, now is the time to start a dialogue about securing equal rights to peaceful and dignified life for every person on earth. It is necessary to know what the current leadership thinks and how the leaders act, and asked them to work towards peace.

Your Holiness, only you among all the leaders of the world and our region have come close to reinforce our belief that the world will finally and without inhibitions look for solutions to the important issues such as poverty, hunger, fear of suffering, terror and hardships of war, health and fulfillment of the meaning of life.
