this sincere greeting comes to you from Bratislava where 400 businesspeople and public officials have been associated with the Informal Economic
Forum (IEF) for the past ten years. This "Economic Club "is a community of
citizens and global and international organizations. Prominent personalities
from several countries, such as the first President of the Slovak Republic,
Michal Kovác, the current President, R. Schuster, and His Eminence Cardinal
Ján Chryzostom Korec, are honorary members. It has been an honor for us
that several of your fellow citizens, such as John Naisbitt, Professor Jeffrey
Sachs, Ambassadors of the United States Theodor Russels and Ralph Johnson,
as well as the Voice of America have expressed interest in our activities.

As a community in a small nation, the IEF, which is independent from political parties, has been trying to develop relations with other countries. We have been able to find personalities whom we not only highly appreciate for their life attitudes and wisdom, but who are also a major inspiration for our everyday life. In the Spring of 1999, at the time when you were still Governor of Texas, we eached the conclusion that you are such a personality who is a model for us not only in a wide range of opinions and attitudes, but also in practical politics.
